Dear Sir,

In accordance with articles 9 and 10, second paragraph of Law 18045, and as established under Chilean General Norm 30 of the Financial Market Commission and in use of the powers conferred upon me, I hereby inform you of the following significant event regarding the business of Enel Generación Chile S.A. (the "Company"):

On August 2, 2022, Law 21472 (the "MPC Law") was published in the official gazette. This Law created a Tariff Stabilization Fund ("FET" in its Spanish acronym), and established a new transitional regulated customer tariff stabilization mechanism for up to US\$ 1.8 billion, whose validity will be extended until the balances originated by application of the MPC Law are extinguished, to expire no later than December 31, 2032. Exempt Resolution 86, as amended by Exempt Resolution 334/2023, both issued by the National Energy Commission, established the provisions, procedures, terms, and conditions for the MPC LAW to be implemented properly.

To implement the tariff stabilization mechanism established by the MPC Law and the Exempt Resolutions, the Ministry of Finance delegated to the Chilean Treasury Department, and as representative of the FET, the issuance of a transferrable Payment Document to be cashed in by the holder of such document and on the date determined by the document, as payment for the amounts accrued, including interest, resulting from Law MPC and the electricity tariff stabilization mechanism.

I hereby inform that on this date, the Company, as the selling party, signed a contract in English titled Purchase Facility Agreement ("PFA") with **(i)** Inter-American Investment Corporation ("IDB Invest") as the buyer; and **(ii)** Citibank, N.A., as the Purchase Facility Agent. Pursuant to the PFA, the Company has agreed to sell, assign, and transfer to IDB Invest that agreed to buy, accept, and acquire for itself, from time to time, certain Payment Documents paid to the order of the Company resulting from the implementation of the tariff stabilization mechanism established by Law MPC, subject to the terms and conditions described in such contract, for up to approximately US\$ 606 million.

The first set of documents to the order of the Company to be sold, assigned, and transferred to IDB, according to the terms and conditions of the PFA, will amount to approximately US\$ 295 million, and will have a positive impact on the Company's cash account by the same amount. This operation is subject to compliance with certain precedent conditions, and the funds are expected to be available in the coming weeks.

After the first sale of Payment Documents, new Payment Documents are expected to be issued to the order of the Company, from time to time, to reach a total aggregate amount of approximately US\$ 606 million. The potential sale of future Document Payments issued to the order of the Company as a consequence of the MPC Law enforcement are subject to the fulfillment of various conditions and the financial effects of these transactions are not defined on this date.
