Santiago, February 8, 2021. Enel Chile was confirmed in The Sustainability Yearbook 2021, an annual study that compares listed companies' sustainability performance based on a competitive evaluation. The Yearbook included Enel Chile within the Silver Class for its excellent performance, ranging between 1% and 5% of its industry's most sustainable companies worldwide. Enel Chile is the only Latin American electrical company in this position.

Paolo Pallotti, CEO of Enel Chile, said: *"This recognition, which allows us to advance to the Silver category from last year's Bronze, highlights the continuous improvement in our performance with the environment, society, and good corporate governance practices. We work with sustainability at the center of our business model, leading a fair and inclusive energy transition that contributes to the country's development"*.
