Preferential Attention for Electrodependent Customers

Patients who are electro-dependent and registered with the company receive priority telephone assistance, as long as they call from the numbers provided at the time of registration. Enel Distribución encourages family members and guardians of electro-dependent individuals to register as soon as possible to ensure personalized support during emergencies.

To register, you need to submit an application that includes the patient's information and the location of home hospitalization, along with a medical certificate that specifies the required equipment.
