ENEL X AND MUNICIPALITY OF SANTIAGO INAUGURATE NEW LED PUBLIC LIGHTING IN STREETS NEXT TO PARQUE O'HIGGINS AS PART OF FORMULA E'S LEGACY

- *The project is part of Enel X's legacy in the framework of running the FIA Formula E race in Santiago on January 26th at Parque O'Higgins*

Santiago, January 17, 2019 – To increase the security of the area, improve the luminosity of the neighborhoods, achieve significant efficiency in consumption, and attain significant economic savings, are the main benefits that the replacement of the public lighting will bring to the residents of Santiago on Beaucheff, Tupper, General Rondizzoni, and Pedro Montt streets.

The project involves installing modern, efficient, and environmentally-friendly LED technology, which will signify significant savings for the municipality of Santiago. The new street lighting was inaugurated by the mayor of Santiago, Felipe Alessandri; Enel Chile's CEO, Paolo Pallotti; and Enel X Chile's General Manager, Karla Zapata.

This project, led by Enel X Chile, was carried out within the framework of the new date for the FIA Formula E race to be held at Parque O'Higgins on Saturday, January 26th, as part of the Enel Group's contribution to the community.

"One of the pillars of Enel X is to offer integrated, friendly, and innovative digital solutions for cities. This project, developed together with the Municipality of Santiago, seeks to contribute to the community through technology that allows a much more efficient use of energy, satisfying the needs of residents and improving their quality of life," indicated Enel Chile's CEO, **Paolo Pallotti**.

"Improvements in the road and pedestrian lighting around Parque O'Higgins were a necessity that the neighbors had been requesting for some time now, and, thanks to Enel's support, we are fulfilling that need and installing more than 300 new lights in the entire area, which will undoubtedly improve the security of the neighborhood. This project is added to those chosen by the community through participatory consultation, which includes new security cameras, new bathrooms, and new playgrounds inside the Park and security cameras, sidewalk and road repair, and the recovery of green areas outside the park," stated Santiago's mayor, **Felipe Alessandri**,

"We are delighted to contribute our grain of sand in order to improve visibility in the park. Thanks to our Partner Enel and to Mayor Felipe Alessandri for allowing us to take part in actions such as the installation of new street lights and that the economic contribution made to the municipality be used in benefits for the neighbors. This proves that Formula E wants to be an active part of the transformation of the district of Santiago. Our intention is to stay here for many years and we know the importance of being good neighbors in order to achieve that. In this second edition of the Antofagasta Mineral Santiago E-Prix, we have learned from the past and with the help of the Mayor and the Intendant we looked for a place that provides versatility



without disturbing the neighbors," commented **Alberto Longo**, Co-Founder and Chief Championship Officer of the Formula E.

LED Lighting Project

The street lighting replacement project for the streets near Parque O'Higgins, includes 167 LED lights for streets and another 132 units for pedestrian areas, which were placed on the stretch between Av. Beaucheff, Tupper, General Rondizzoni, and Pedro Montt.

The new public lighting uses LED technology that is friendlier to the environment and more efficient with a 56.9% reduction of power consumption with a total of 35,237 Kwh. Moreover, this type of project makes cities safer and friendlier, contributing to their recovery and improving the residents' sense of security.

Enel X is promoting the penetration of an energy efficiency culture in the country, not only by making people aware of the rational use of energy, but also by stimulating the permanent development of products and services. In the case of efficient public lighting, Enel X has been awarded the task of installing more than 170,000 LED street lights, in different districts throughout the country.
